
COHO



The goal at COHO has always been to make balanced, supple wines that reflect the rich, nuanced fruit and crisp acidity that are the hallmark characteristics of the cooler climate vineyards of Napa Valley. Our 2018 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is an aromatic, deeply flavored, elegant wine that reflects all our winemaking aspirations.

The Cabernet Sauvignon in this wine was grown on the prestigious Sugarloaf East Vineyard on a hillside southeast of downtown Napa. The Petit Verdot is from the Chinn Vineyard, a small family run vineyard in Coombsville. These fog cooled sites imbue aromas of boysenberry and plums, with light currant and baking spices undertones. The flavors are seamless and silky, displaying dark fruits that delightfully linger as the wine disappears.

Varietal Composition: 94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Petit Verdot

Appellation: Napa Valley

Crush: 100% whole berries

Pre-fermentation: Cold-soaked for 3 days at 55 degrees F.

Fermentation: 7 days followed by malo-lactic fermentation in barrels

Aging: 21 months in 100% French oak barrels, 50% new for the vintage

Bottled: August 13, 2020

Production: 147 cases
