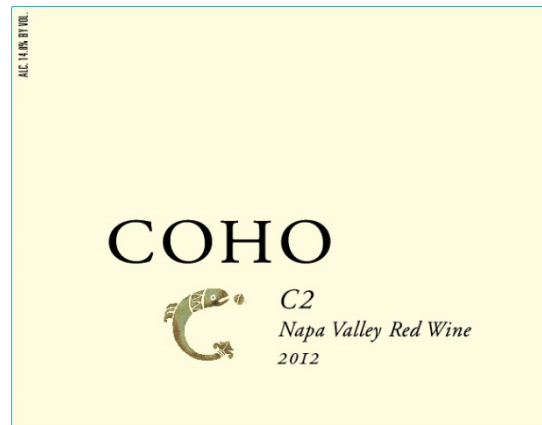


COHO



To celebrate its 10th Anniversary in 2012 COHO has created a commemorative wine, **C2** – Combination of the Two. Fruit selection is from our two top single vineyard wines, SummitVine Ranch Cabernet Sauvignon and Michael Black Vineyard Merlot with an assist from the Chinn Vineyard Petit Verdot. James Suckling has described the wine as *“Fresh and beautiful with blueberry, boysenberry and spice character. Hints of cedar and wood too. Full body, firm tannins and a bright finish. Gorgeous. Drink or hold. 93 Points”*

Varietal Composition:	54% Merlot, 41% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot
Appellation:	Napa Valley (from Coombsville and Diamond Mountain)
Clone:	Merlot-Black, Cabernet Sauvignon-337, Petit Verdot-181
Crush:	100% whole berries
Pre-fermentation:	5 days cold soak at 55 degrees F.
Fermentation:	8 days followed by malo-lactic fermentation in barrels
Aging:	21 months in 100% French oak barrels, 50% new
Bottled:	July 21, 2014
Production:	277 cases (9 liter equivalent)
Release Date:	October 1, 2015
