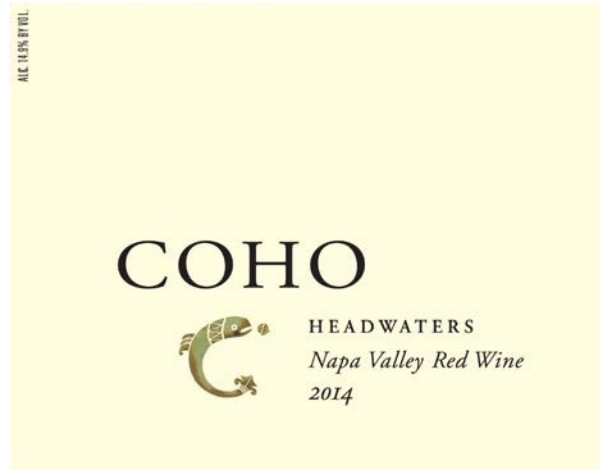


COHO



Grown primarily in the cool-climate Coombsville appellation of the Napa Valley, the 2014 HEADWATERS is a vibrant, richly layered wine. Proximity to the San Pablo Bay imparts spicy aromatic and flavor complexities, while the gravel and volcanic-rock strewn soils contribute to the mineral notes that roll on the palate and finish.

A focused purity of gorgeous red and blue fruits infuse a core of currant and pomegranate flavors. This is an elegant wine that despite its early approachability will continue to reveal additional complexities for the next five to seven years.

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| Varietal Composition: | 56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, 11% Petite Verdot |
