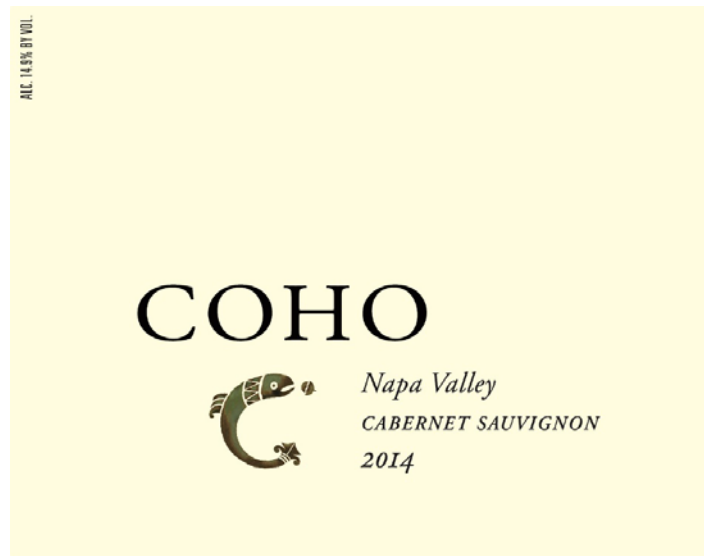


COHO



2014 was a best of both worlds vintage, the forward, rich flavors reminiscent of Napa's 2012 harvest with excellent structure similar to 2013. This wine is sourced from four small, family-owned vineyards located in Yountville, and Coombsville. Enticing floral aromas of lilac and sage leads to mouth-filling flavors of blue and black berries with hints of mocha. The front loaded style is round and juicy with lots rich fruit. The 2014 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a supple and balanced wine that is eminently drinkable now, but will continue to develop complexity and finesse as it ages.

Varietal Composition:	77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 1% Petit Verdot

Crush:	100% whole berries
Pre-fermentation:	Cold-soaked for 3 days at 55 degrees F.
Fermentation:	8 days followed by malo-lactic fermentation in barrels
Aging:	21 months in 100% French oak barrels, 50% new for the vintage
