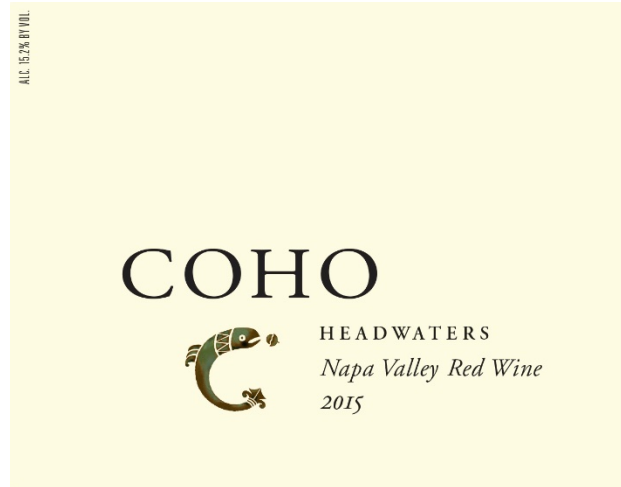


COHO



Grown primarily in the cool-climate Coombsville appellation of the Napa Valley, the 2015 HEADWATERS is a vibrant, richly layered wine. Proximity to the San Pablo Bay imparts spicy aromatic and flavor complexities, while the gravel and volcanic-rock strewn soils contribute to the mineral notes that roll on the palate and finish.

A focused purity of gorgeous red and blue fruits infuse a core of currant and pomegranate flavors. This is a rich, dark wine that will continue to reveal additional complexities for the next five to seven years.

Varietal Composition:	46% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 19% Petite Verdot

Crush:	100% whole berries
Pre-fermentation:	3 day cold soak at 50 degrees F.
Fermentation:	Approximately 10 days, 7 day extended maceration, malo-lactic fermentation in barrel
Aging:	21 months in 100% French Oak, 40% new for the vintage
