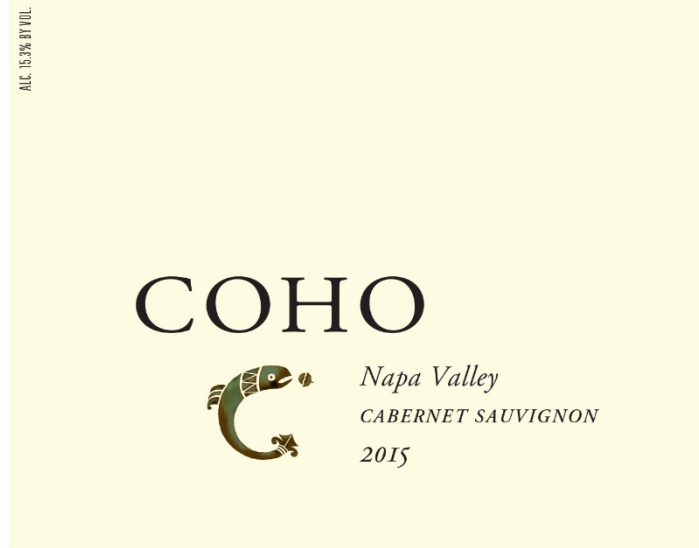


# COHO



This Cabernet Sauvignon was grown on the prestigious Sugarloaf East Vineyard on a hillside southeast of downtown Napa. The Petit Verdot is from the Chinn Vineyard in Coombsville. The cool climate setting for both vineyards elicits spicy nuances in the aromatics and on the palate, while the lively black cherry, cassis and licorice flavors are underlain by silky, resolved tannins. The 2015 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a lovely, elegant wine already revealing its charms, but will continue to develop complexity and finesse as it ages.

Varietal Composition:	90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot
Appellation:	Napa Valley
Crush:	100% whole berries
Pre-fermentation:	Cold-soaked for 3 days at 55 degrees F.
Fermentation:	7 days followed by malo-lactic fermentation in barrels
Aging:	21 months in 100% French oak barrels, 50% new for the vintage
Bottled:	June 28, 2017
Production:	208 cases
